**GILNAHIRK ROAD / KINGS ROAD, BELFAST – RE CROSSING GILNAHIRK ROAD**

Thank you for your email of 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019 regarding the provision of a pedestrian crossing facility on Gilnahirk Road at Kings Road. Our position has not changed and remains as I outlined in my letter to you on 20 March last year.

As advised previously, our assessment for the provision of a pedestrian crossing on Gilnahirk Road at Kings Road indicated that this location was situated well down our priority list for a pedestrian crossing facility when compared to other locations in the Belfast area.

Due to this low prioritisation our position remains that we have no plans to provide additional pedestrian facilities at the Gilnahirk Road / kings Road junction.

I trust this information is helpful and fully explains our position on this issue.
